3 STANDING ORDER No. 1

4 Rules of Decorum

5 Effective April 2, 2014

6 **Rule 1:**

7 No tobacco in any form, and no food or drink, except plain water, shall be permitted in
8 the courtroom.

9 **Rule 2:**

10 No hats, caps or other headgear shall be worn in the courtroom. No one may remain
11 standing while court is in session.

12 **Rule 3:**

13 No signs or banners are allowed in the courtroom. There shall be no demonstrations of
14 any kind in the courtroom while court is in session. There shall be no unnecessary
15 conversation, loud whispering, newspaper or magazine reading in the courtroom while
16 court is in session.

17 **Rule 4:**

18 Cellular telephones and pagers must be turned off before entering the courtroom gallery.

19 **Rule 5:**

20 Any distracting or disconcerting activity will be grounds for removal from the courtroom.

21 **Rule 6:**

22 Tape recorders, video recording devices and still cameras are prohibited in the courtroom
23 without the prior consent of the Court.

24 **Rule 7:**

 Children must be under the control and supervision of an adult at all times.

Rule 8:

 At the opening of each court day, the Court Bailiff shall direct all present to stand, and
 shall clearly and distinctly say: "All rise, the Fond du Lac Tribal Court is now in Session,
 the Honorable [name of presiding judge] is presiding."

Rule 9:

 It shall be the duty of the Court Bailiff to maintain order at all times as attorneys and the
 public assemble in the courtroom. This duty shall include removing persons for
 distracting or discordant behavior, admitting persons to the courtroom and directing them
 to seats, and refusing admittance to the courtroom when the courtroom is filled to its
 seating capacity.


Rule 11:
