5	Section 113 of The Civil Code of the Fond du Lac Band of Lake Superior Chippewa provides as follows:
7	ADMISSION TO PRACTICE. Any person admitted to practice and is [sic] in
8	good standing before the bar of any State or the District of Columbia shall be deemed to be admitted to practice before the Fond du Lac Court. The Court may, in its sound discretion, admit non-attorneys to practice before it, provided
9	that such individuals have demonstrated familiarity with the principles of Indian law and conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the ethical standards and rules of decorum of the Fond du Lac Court.
10	
11	1. Attorney Admission
12	An attorney licensed in any State or the District of Columbia shall, upon his or her first appearance in the Fond du Lac Tribal Court, submit an affidavit
13 14	providing the attorney's bar number in the jurisdiction where he or she is licensed, and a statement that the attorney is in good standing in the licensing jurisdiction.
15	2. Non-attorney Admission
16	A non-attorney seeking permission to practice before the Fond du Lac Tribal Court shall submit a Petition for Admission to Practice. The Petition shall
17	describe the Petitioner's familiarity with the principles of Indian Law and shall include the Petitioner's statement that, if admitted, the Petitioner will
18	conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the ethical standards and rules of decorum of the Court.
19	In its sole discretion, the Court may hold a hearing on the Petition.
20	In its sole discretion, the Court may hold a hearing on the retution.
