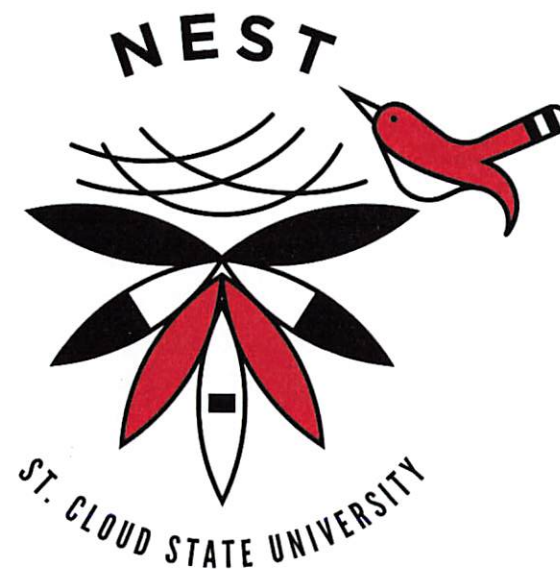

Have you ever had a Native Teacher?

Minnesota has approximately 24,500 American Indian K-12 students and fewer than 300 licensed Native classroom teachers.

Diversity among educational professionals is critical for success of all students. Minnesota kids need Native educators.

St. Cloud State University has grant funds available for American Indian students seeking Teacher Licensure and/or Education-related programs/careers.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Priority is given to American Indian students who are tribally enrolled and then to first and second generation descendants.
- St Cloud State University (undergraduate or graduate) admissions with MITTP eligible major.
- MITTP Scholarship application available at www.stcloudstate.edu/aic
- Free Application for Federal Student Aid/FAFSA with financial need that remains unmet by government guidelines and determined by SCSU Financial Aid Office.
